SUBJECT:	Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Year 2008 Reprogramming

REQUEST:

That City Council conduct a public hearing and adopt reprogramming allocation amounts for the Program Year (PY) 2008 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The City of Rochester Hills will hold a public hearing on October 18, 2010, regarding the PY 2008 CDBG proposed reprogramming of funding allocations. By choosing the option to reprogram, it is ensured that the funds will be expended in a timely manner and not risk recapture. The City has funds available from PY 2008 that were committed to Public Services – Yard Services. These funds would be reallocated to the Minor Home Repair program, which has seen a huge increase in demand due to the tough economic conditions. This reallocation would not diminish the level of service provided for the Yard Services, as the services have been able to continue at lower costs than estimated.
