SUBJECT: "2005" Pathway Rehabilitation Project

REQUEST:

The Department of Public Service recommends accepting the bid and awarding a contract for the 2005 Pathway Rehabilitation Project to Pro-Line Asphalt Paving of Washington, Michigan as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$217,965.56 and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute a contract on behalf of the City.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

On Thursday, June 2, 2005, the City received three (3) sealed bids for the 2005 Pathway Rehabilitation Project including the Pathway Gap Construction at Tienken and Whispering Willow. Of the three (3) bids received, Pro-Line Asphalt Paving was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The bid received from Pro-Line Asphalt is 1% below the engineering cost estimate, which is shown on the attached bid tabulation. Work is expected to begin in July 2005 with a completion date scheduled for September 15, 2005.

The Scope of Work for this project includes the rehabilitation of approximately 3.25 miles of existing 8' wide HMA pathway and construction of approximately 670' of 8' wide HMA pathway.

BUDGET:

Cost associated with the 2005 Pathway Rehabilitation is identified in the 2005 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and in the approved 2005 budget identified as PW-09.

Cost associated with the Pathway Gap Construction at Tienken and Whispering Willow was identified in the 2004 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and in the approved 2004 budget identified as PW-02 in the amount of \$63,250. A budget amendment will be required.
