Good Afternoon Mrs. Schankin,

The revised photometric plans have not been provided at this time. They will be required to submit them as part of their conditions review (after City Council approval of the conditional use). The requirement for the change of fixtures will generate the need for a new photometric plan as well. In regards to the fixture cutoffs or shielding, the currently proposed fixtures have flat lenses and the fixture should be directed straight downward. Based on the currently submitted photometric plan, the lighting cast by the fixtures will be very limited north of the actual parking lot area and should be further shielded by the existing and proposed landscape to the north of the parking lot. However, if there is a concern with excessive glare after installation, the City's Ordinances will require a remedy to be enacted.

The Oakland Gospel requests went to the Planning Commission on Tuesday, they approved the site plan and tree removal permit, and recommended the conditional use for approval. The conditional use will be scheduled (most likely) for the February 12th City Council meeting. Your comments will be provided to City Council.
