SUBJECT: Request for Authorization to Submit Local Consent Agreement for Participation in the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP)

REQUEST:

It is requested that the Rochester Hills City Council authorize the City to submit the Local Consent Agreement for the City to participate in grant funding for Cybersecurity Assessments, and Incident Response Planning and Training Activities as pass through services based on funding requirements received by the State and authorize the Mayor to execute the Local Consent Agreement on behalf of the City.

BACKGROUND:

The State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP) is administered by the Department of Homeland Security and funded by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. The SLCGP is a reimbursable pass-through grant program with an overall goal to improve the cybersecurity posture of state, local and territorial government organizations by providing assistance for managing and reducing systemic cyber risk through identified program objectives.

The State of Michigan was awarded \$9.6 million dollars for the upcoming Fiscal Year Ended which provides opportunities for more investment into cyber risk reduction and sub-grant for projects approved in the Michigan SLCGP funds Michigan Cybersecurity Plan.

The City received notification that they are eligible to participate in the upcoming grant program and will be eligible for the following two (2) programs through the grant program: (1) Incident response planning and training and (2) Cybersecurity Assessments.

By participating in this grant program, the City will be able to take advantage these cybersecurity initiatives that will enhance our current and future computing environments, reducing our risk.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Rochester Hills City Council authorize the City to submit the Local Consent Agreement for the City to participate in grant funding for Cybersecurity Assessments, and Incident Response Planning and Training Activities as pass through services based on funding requirements received by the State and authorize the Mayor to execute the Local Consent Agreement on behalf of the City.
