REQUEST:

The Department of Public Services requests that the Rochester Hills City Council pass a resolution supporting the Transportation Economic Development Fund (TEDF) application request for the rehabilitation of Hamlin Road from Old Adams to New Adams as part of the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) Transportation Economic Development Fund Program. The City Council also commits to providing the matching funds necessary to carry out the project if awarded TECF.

BACKGROUND:

Hamlin Road from Old Adams to New Adams is currently under the jurisdiction of the Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC). The existing condition of said stretch of roadway is in poor condition and a rehabilitation project is not identified in a future Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). A local business recently purchased a building along this segment of Hamlin Road, which provides the opportunity to pursue Transportation Economic Development Funds. The RCOC is willing to participate in the project rehabilitation costs for Hamlin Road and has agreed to be the sponsor of a TEDF application.

The TEDF application request is for \$1,200,000 or approximately 22% of the entire project cost. If awarded the TEDF, the City's participatory share would be \$2,092,213 or approximately 38% of the total estimated project costs of \$5,384,427.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Services recommends that the Rochester Hills City Council pass a resolution in support of the Transportation Economic Development Fund (TEDF) application request for Hamlin Road from Old Adams to New Adams as part of the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) Transportation Economic Development Fund Program. The City Council also commits to provide the necessary matching funds to carry out the project if awarded TEDF.
