Traffic Study Summary For Texas at Walton "No Parking" Sign Removals – PK-57.1

Background

The homeowner at 22 Texas, who recently purchased the home, called in to the City requesting that the "No Parking" signs along Texas, just north of Walton, be removed.

Summary

The new homeowner had indicated that based upon discussions with the previous property owner, the reason the signs were originally installed was due to the home being utilized as a "Group Home" type facility and street parking problems associated with its use.

The reasoning for removing the signs is that guests of the new homeowner were issued parking violations by the Sheriff's Department for parking in the street.

The engineering department has verified with the Building Department that indeed this home is owned by a new property owner and is no longer being used as "Group Home" facility.

Conclusion

Based upon the information above, the recommendation is made that the signs be removed, as they no longer serve their original intent. Attached is a copy of the original TCO PK-57.1.
