SUBJECT: 2005-2006 Police School Liaison Agreement

REQUEST:

To request that City Council approve and the Mayor sign the financial agreement for the 2005-2006 Police School Liaison Program for the upcoming school year, between the Rochester Community School District, the City of Rochester, Oakland Township and the City of Rochester Hills.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

For many years, Rochester Community School District (RCS), the City of Rochester, Oakland Township and the City of Rochester Hills have joined together to finance and provide for a police school liaison educational program by continuing an inter-governmental agreement pursuant to and under the authority of Public Act 35 of 1951 of the State of Michigan, as amended (MCL 124.1 et seq). The program is believed to be a great public benefit by building respect for law enforcement and preventing present and future crime, among other reasons.

The total cost for the 2005-2006 program is \$531,672 (plus overtime paid by RCS). By contract the Rochester Community Schools contributes 19.6% (\$104,208) of the cost. According to school population counts, Oakland Township will contribute \$81,218(19%), the City of Rochester will contribute \$42,746 (10%) and City of Rochester Hills will contribute \$303,499 (71%) of the balance (80.4%). Relative to last year, a 1% shift in contribution moved from Rochester Hills to Oakland Township.

Costs for the program are determined according to the police contract rates between the City of Rochester Hills and the Oakland County Sheriff's Department.
