Nomination Form – Older Persons’ Commission (OPC) – 2 Members

1. President **opens** the floor for nominations
(Each Council Member may nominate 2 candidates. No second required)

2. When nominations are completed, President **closes** the floor for nominations.
3. President specifies names of nominees and calls for a **Roll Call Vote** for Council Members to indicate their choice.

(Majority Vote is elected. If no majority vote, nominee with fewest numbers of votes is dropped and voting continues until 2 nominees receives the majority vote.)

4. President announces nominees appointed to the OPC for a one-year term to expire December 2, 2024.

ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURE:

If Council discussion narrows nominees down to two, and Council agrees, President may announce the nominees that were appointed to OPC.
