NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TO ROCHESTER HILLS RESIDENTS:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE ROCHESTER HILLS CITY COUNCIL, in accordance with the Charter for the City of Rochester Hills, Chapter III, Section 3.5, will hold a PUBLIC HEARING on the Proposed 2005 Budget Plan which was submitted by the Mayor to City Council, in accordance with the Charter, at its August 4, 2004 Meeting.

The Public Hearing on the Proposed 2005 Budget Plan will be held at the Rochester Hills City Council Regular Meeting on Wednesday, September 15, 2004, commencing at 7:30 p.m., Michigan time, at 1000 Rochester Hills Drive, Rochester Hills, Michigan 48309. **“The property tax millage rate proposed to be levied to support the proposed budget will be a subject of this hearing.”**

In addition, during these same proceedings, the Rochester Hills City Council will hold a Public Hearing on the Older Persons Commission (OPC) Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2005, and on the Rochester Avon Recreation Authority (RARA) Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2005.

A copy of the Proposed 2005 Budget Plan is on file and available to the public for inspection during regular business hours (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.), at the Office of the City Clerk and Fiscal Department, 1000 Rochester Hills Drive, Rochester Hills, Oakland County, Michigan. A copy of the 2005 Budget Plan is also on file at the Rochester Hills Public Library.
