Land and Water Conservation Fund

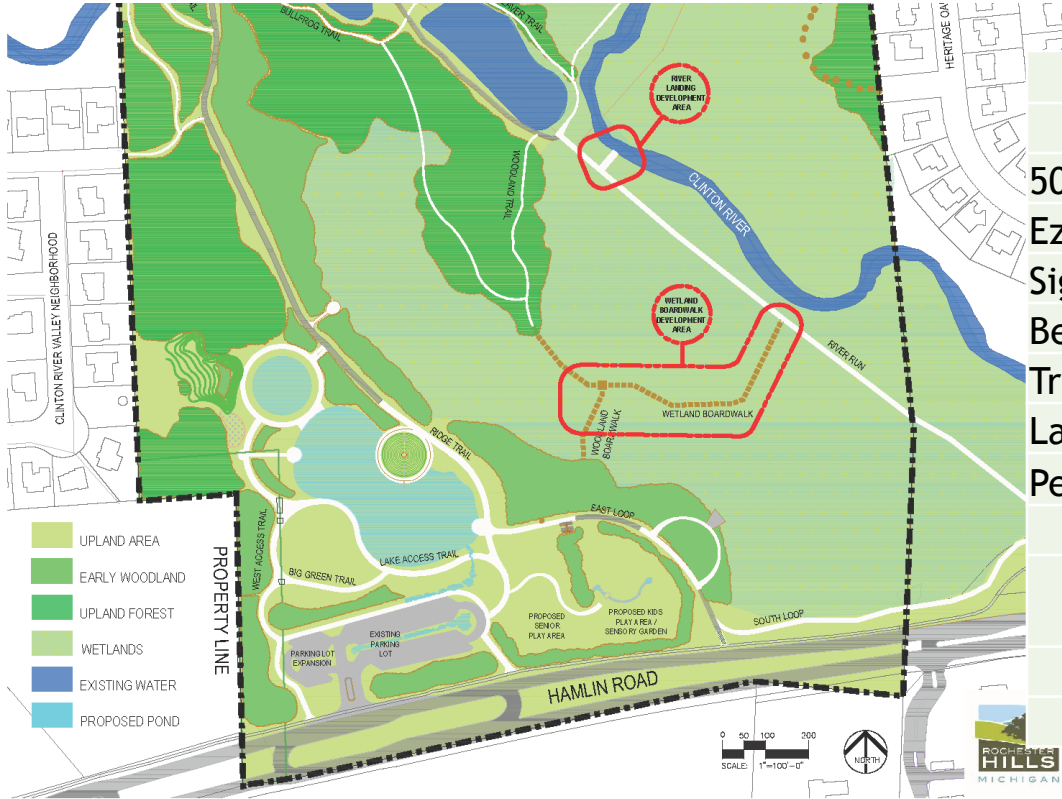
- ▶ Funding originates from the royalties of oil and gas leases on the Outer Continental Shelf
- ▶ Distributed at the Federal level by the National Park Service
- ▶ Managed at the State level by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources
- ▶ Reimbursable grant
- ▶ 2017 Maximum Grant \$150,000 (\$300,000 project)
- ▶ Required Project Match 50%



Grant Application Timeline

- ▶ April 1, 2017 - Grant Application due
- ▶ January 2018- MDNR notifies applicants about status
- ▶ Summer 2018 - Project Agreement from the MDNR comes back to City for signature
- ▶ Fall 2018 - Construction begins on project
