- \* Letter should include key points: General routine maintenance, snow plowing and salting.

- \* Presentation showed numbers accurately.

- \* Special Assessment Districts vs. Millage basically triples the cost to the resident.
- \* Mr. Staran approved Town Hall meeting video and the tape is currently running on channel 55.

- \* Requests received from subdivisions to provide fact sheets.
