Dear Bryan Barnett:

The Older Persons' Commission Governing Board is requesting to be on the August 3, 2010 primary election ballot for all three communities to renew the Older Persons' Commission .25 mill. The language will be similar to the one passed in 2001.

Shall the City of Rochester renew a tax levy of one-quarter (1/4) mill on the taxable value of all property assessed for taxes in the City for purposes of transportation, activities and services for older persons and to operate, equip and maintain an Older Persons' Activity Center, the tax to be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, the years 2012 through 2021, inclusive, which would provide an estimated revenue of \$ XXX,XXX in the first year of such levy?

The OPC Governing Board would like to make a presentation at your monthly meeting in March or April. It was felt that we would like to put the ballot question on this years primary as all three communities will have an election at the same time on August 3, 2010 and it was also felt we needed to have another opportunity if needed in 2011, because of the economy within the OPC service area. The millage will help your seniors live independent with dignity as long as possible within your community, and is very much appreciated.
