REQUEST:

Request for authorization of a blanket purchase order to Esri (Environmental Systems Research Institute) of Redlands, California in the amount not-to-exceed \$195,000.00 for 2022, 2023, and 2024 GIS software maintenance fees.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

ArcGIS Enterprise, developed by Esri, is the foundational software system we use for our Geographic Information Systems (GIS), powering mapping and visualization, analytics, and data management. It is the backbone for running the system of records, the system of insight, and the system of engagement.

To better serve our residents and the community as a whole, the City of Rochester Hills embraces location based technology and all the insights that come with it to make data-driven decisions. This product is designed to:

- Capture, store, manage and present authoritative data, providing everybody with the same information
