# CONTROLLING TURNING MOVEMENTS ON CITY STREETS

ORDER No: TM-10

In accordance with Act No. 300, P.A. 1949 (Michigan Vehicle Code) and City Ordinance Chapter 7.09 (Rochester Hills Traffic Code), as amended, we have made a traffic engineering investigation and as a result of said investigation have determined that turning movements from the location(s) described below are dangerous to those using the street and would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic, and hereby direct that:

- TM-10.1 All Vehicle Traffic Exiting Hampton Village Center Westerly Driveway onto Auburn Road Must Turn Right Only. Driveway Located on the North Side of Auburn Road 535' East of Rochester Rd.
- TM-10.2 All Vehicle Traffic Exiting Builders Square Shopping Center Driveway onto Barclay Circle Must Turn Right Only. Driveway Located on the West Side of Barclay Circle 600' North of Auburn Rd.

This Order becomes effective when a certified copy hereof is filed with he City Clerk of Rochester Hills, Michigan and signs and/or markings in conformity with the Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices giving notice of the same have been placed and maintained.

This traffic control order shall not be effective after the expiration of 90 days from date of issuance and shall not be renewed or extended, except upon approval by City Council.
