Uniform Trailways Ordinances

- · Limits commercial activity
- Horses/Dogs
- No trespassing to adjacent lands
- No motorized vehicles


Paint Creek Trail Patrol Program

Trail User Demographics

- 2004 MSU Study
- May-Sept: 67,000 users
- > 56% : bicyclists
- > 44%: walkers/runners
- > 90%: Oakland County residents or
- > 53% male, 47% female
- > 51% lived within 2 miles of the Trail
- > 3%: disabled
- > Improvements wanted?


