The Langeron Charity is a 501 (c) (3) organization that exist to support the community of Rochester Hills and other community in state Michigan. The mission of the Langeron Charities is organizing events attributed to Ukrainian History (lectures, ethnic songs and dances, dining, etc.).

- Assistance with transportation and search of housing.
- Purchases of food, furniture and clothes for new emigrants.
- Purchases of computers, phones and other appliances to support new emigrants and pure
 people in Ukrainian community Assist Ukrainian émigrés in their adaptation to their new
 country through educational and cultural programs on legal, civic, economic and social issues;
- Assisting the Ukrainian émigrés into the American community by educating them in American cultural, historical, literary, and religious traditions.

Since being established in 2009 Langeron Charities has conducted fund raising events to raise money, clothes and foods from different organizations and donors for recent immigrants.

Some of the activities and efforts to raise funds in the community during the events were:

- Organizing evens attributed to Ukrainian History (lectures, ethnic songs and dances, dining, ect.)
- Program and services in furtherance of these activities have included free-of-charge distribution "Voters education" brochures, coordinating medical assistance to victims of terrorist acts.
- Tours to museums and other cultural centers too.
- Near future plans to have drives for donation of canned foods, clothes and other items to help pure people in Ukraine Crises.
- The activities have been conducted by corporation staff and volunteers
