ell. Rear ell and wing appear to be additions, probably early. Screened porch on east side has brick floor, foundation, and patio. Larger screened porch on west rear has brick foundation. Front porch with square posts, brick floor and foundation. Brick chimney rear of main house. 2/2 windows,

pedimented window heads.

Statement of Significance The 1896 atlas map shows 120 acres owned by H. Pennington and two houses. The 1938 rural

property inventory shows this house on an 80 acre parcel owned by Wm. D. McCullough.

According to earlier surveys, this was the tenant house on Fairview Farm. Alterations to this house include alteration of the side porch and removal of gingerbread trim in 1950; alteration of front and side porches with addition of brick in 1975; master bedroom addition in 1986; family room addition

in 1998.
