SUBJECT: Thermoplastic Marking Program “2009”

REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize the award of the contract for the “2009” Thermoplastic Marking Program to R.S. Contracting Inc, of Casco, Michigan in the amount of \$42,029.94 with a 5% contingency of \$2,101.50 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$44,131.44.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) recently received bids for their “2009” County-Wide Thermoplastic Marking Program. R.S. Contracting, Inc. was awarded the RCOC contract, as the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. R.S. Contracting, Inc has agreed to extend the RCOC pricing to the City of Rochester Hills for the “2009” construction season.

The Thermoplastic Marking Program “2009” includes the application of sprayable thermoplastic for the City’s white and yellow longitudinal lines.
