

Thank you for your recent inquiries regarding the permit project at the Saint Paul's Albanian Catholic Church on Auburn Rd just east of M-59 in Rochester Hills.

As you know, we have had many discussions over the past few months regarding what work needed to be done along Auburn Rd in conjunction with the permit. After discussion with the city of Rochester Hills and internally within the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT), we would like to see the following cross section placed on Auburn Rd:

- Maintain existing EB Auburn roadway width and striping.
- Widen the WB Auburn shoulder to a paved 12 feet, with full-depth asphalt construction similar to the mainline Auburn Rd pavement cross section. The widening should extend between Harrington Rd and Walbridge Dr. These improvements were already described in the initial permit for the site improvements.
- Stripe WB Auburn with one 12' WB through lane. No extra pavement markings shall be placed on the widened section of

If this work is done, this will be sufficient improvements to allow the permit to be closed out from an MDOT perspective. We will need to see plans to complete these improvements and process an amendment to the existing permit.

Hey Ed,

I just noticed that now when you wrote this email - must have been as leep at the switch proofreading the document that day :)

The intent of that statement was to have one WB lane of Auburn, 12' wide. The only pavement markings will be the yellow centerline stripe and the white edge line. The extra pavement Frank is constructing shall not be striped at all aside from those two markings.
