- 2 Dated Feb 28, 1852 and Recorded Mar 1, 1853 Levi & Sarah LeRoy sold the 81 acres to Eli H. Bristol:
 "Except ... a parcel of land taken from the southeast corner of the said first described parcel of land 5 rods by 8,
 so far as the same is leased to fractional School District No. 1 in Troy and Avon."
 (40 square Rods) Liber 47 of Deeds, pg 281-283
- 3 Dated Aug - , 1882, Recorded Feb 24, 1883 in Liber 1 of Miscellaneous Records, page 386.
 Lease from Henry C Blouch To School District No. 1
 80 square rods "for so long as the said (school) district shall occupy the said above described parcel of land
 for school purposes. And the said party of the second part for themselves and their assignees do covenant
 and agree that when the said above described parcel of land shall cease to be used for school purposes then
 this agreement shall become null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect, and the said party of the
 second part also agrees to build and maintain and keep in good repair the fence around the school house, and
 to pay the said party of the first part for said premises the sum of \$50."

Michigan containing Eighty acres —

according to the official plan of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Joel Melville —

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of
Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Joel Melville —
the said tract above described; To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and au-
thorities, of whatever nature, theretofore belonging, unto the said Joel Melville —
and his — heirs and assigns, forever.

In testimony whereof, I, James Monroe, President, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto
affixed.
