AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 138-4.300, 138-4.302 and 138-8.200 OF CHAPTER138, ZONING, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, TO ADD ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SALES (FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION) TO THE TABLE OF PERMITTED USES BY DISTRICT, REPEAL INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS, AND PRESCRIBE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> This ordinance and each article, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, part, provision, sentence, word and portion thereof are hereby declared to be severable, and if they or any of them are declared to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby provided that the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Penalty</u>. All violations of this ordinance shall be municipal civil infractions and upon a determination of responsibility therefore shall be punishable by a civil fine of not more than \$500, or as otherwise prescribed herein.

Section 6. Repeal, Effective Date, Adoption.
(1) Repeal. All regulatory provisions contained in other City ordinances, which are
inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.
(2) Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on
following its publication in the Oakland Press on, 2015.
(3) Adoption. This ordinance was adopted by the City Council of the City of Rochester
Hills at a meeting thereof held on, 2015.
