BACKGROUND:

Sheriff Michael Bouchard will be providing an update on the Oakland County Sheriff’s Office on Monday, July 26, 2021. He will also present his recommendation for additional positions to the substation.

The Rochester Hills Patrol Division is a division by itself since it maintains such a large contracted law enforcement presence within the City of Rochester Hills, the fourth largest city in Oakland County with 74,000 residents. In addition to performing the conventional duties of law enforcement, the Sheriff's Office maintains a substation in the City of Rochester Hills, which is open Monday-Friday from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, affording residents the ability to:

- Have fingerprints taken.
- Place their house on the House Check List, providing extra patrol during extended periods of vacancy.
- Make reports of incidents or accidents when a police officer was not called to the scene.
- Have officers available to talk to community groups, homeowners' associations and businesses on topics of concern.
