William “Ed” Leafdale

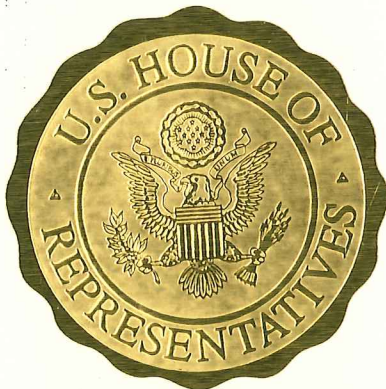
