- Mayor Barnett spoke to the Rochester Hills Government Youth Council and explained his role as Mayor and more information about the City of Rochester Hills.

Dais Reports:

-Isabella Blakeley 12/15/2025: swearing in firefighters and EMT's, celebrated Chad Anderson (Mr. Tennis), Senator Webber came in and gave a legislative update, 31% increase in road funding, public hearing (19% lower budget for this fiscal year), Nowicki Park will be paid for without debt, 59 million allocated for roads, last city council meeting of the year.

Committee Reports and Updates:

- Planning Commission 12/9/2025 (Oliver Blakeley): project to remove a house where the homeowner was not wanting to sell, wanted the area to go to a condominium complex, but it was a problem because it was on wetlands, which would cause drainage issues. Not enough play places, stop signs, other problems. The vote did pass with a unanimous vote. Moving to council on January 12th.

- Sister City 12/9/2025 (Eliza Pizzuti): MOVED TO NEXT MEETING

- RARA 12/17/2025 (Rochester Avon Recreation Authority, Janelle Hayes): Went over the November meeting minute, list of bills, monthly budget. RARA had a holiday party. Their E-Sports company is switching owners, scholarship fund is up to 125 members but has 11k left. Parents night out and it sold out twice in a row. Early registration is opening for summer camps in February. Considering changing the inter local agreement to receive grants from Michigan. The master plan was presented and approved.

- AYA 12/18/2025 (Avondale Youth Assistance, Brennan Deel): Bonus was given out during the meeting, the Scrooge production was seen, and they had a drive for used clothes/shoes.
