SUBJECT: 2008 Sanitary Sewer Lining Program

REQUEST:

The Department of Public Services recommends accepting the bid and awarding a contract for the 2008 Sanitary Sewer Lining Program to Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc. of Brownstown Township, Michigan as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$132,548.00 and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute a contract on behalf of the City.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

On November 13, 2008 the City received five (5) sealed bids for the 2008 Sanitary Sewer Lining Program. Construction is expected to commence January 2009 with final completion no later than 90 days after issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

Through routine televising it was determined that the sanitary sewer was beginning to deteriorate and could be lined in order to extend the service life of the sewer instead of complete replacement. The scope of work for the project consists of lining approximately 4,500 LFT of 8" and 200 LFT of 10" sanitary sewer utilizing the Cured–In-Place lining method. This project includes the repair of the sanitary sewer in Shadow Woods subdivision that was originally approved in the 2008-2013 CIP as SS-44.

The Department of Public services will provide construction services for this project including: inspection, complaint resolution, and contract administration.

BUDGET:

Costs associated with the 2008 Sanitary Sewer Lining Program were identified in the 2008-2013 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and approved in the 2008 budget for \$950,000.00 as SS-02B. Monies for this project may need to be carried over to the FY 2009 Budget, which will require a budget amendment.

The Department of Public Services also requests City Council authorization of a 10% contingency in the amount of \$13,254.80 to allow for quantity adjustments based on final measurements verified in the field.
