Dear Dan,

In support of the Michigan High Tech MEGA application and the Application for Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption Certificate, we have been requested to provide a brief explanation of what our company is, and what we plan to do at our proposed Detroit Technical Center.

Tesla Motors is an automotive original equipment manufacturer (OEM) producing complete vehicles powered exclusively by pure electricity. The company was founded by 2 electrical engineers based out of Silicon Valley California in July 2003. Since then, the company has grown to over 180 people dedicated to engineering and producing lightweight body structures and the complete AC electric motor, battery array and power electronics module to power the vehicle down the road. We have established a battery assembly factory in Thailand, an AC motor factory in Taiwan, and an assembly operation in Hethel, England adjacent to the Lotus factory.

For the first low volume vehicle, we have partnered with Lotus in Hethel, England to help us engineer and assemble the car. Moving forward to our second platform to be produced starting in 2009, we plan to design a family of vehicles (sedan, crossover SUV, coupe, etc) that can be powered by our electric propulsion system. Also, we plan to grow as a car company by establishing a general assembly factory in North America. To achieve these goals, we need to a hire significant number of very well qualified engineering, purchasing and manufacturing professionals. The technical center would house the team engineering, testing, developing, procuring and assuring the quality of the complete light weight vehicle structure, interior and body electrical elements. We have explored employing these individuals at an office directly attached to our assembly factory at an unspecified location in the US as well as employing these people at a separate technical center located in southeast Michigan near the labor pool and supplier pool. There are pro's and con's for whichever location we choose, though we are optimistic that the southeast Michigan location for a technical & development center could be made attractive through the High Tech MEGA and property tax abatement incentives we are applying for.
