ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 54-56, 54-123, 54-466, 54-467 AND 54-470 AND TO ADD DIVISION 2A TO CHAPTER 54, FEES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, TO MODIFY AND SPECIFY FEES RELATING TO MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES, MECHANICAL AMUSEMENT DEVICES, PARKS, MUSEUM AND FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND TO REPEAL CONFLICTING OR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 54-56 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

**Sec. 54-56. Miscellaneous services.**

- (1) Notary services – each signature.....\$5.00
- (2) Passport photographs .....10.00
- (3) Third party release of funds .....75.00
- (4) Refund fee for payment error-property taxes.....20.00
- (5) Refund/transfer for payment in error or with incorrect account number.....20.00

Section 2. Section 54-123 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

**Sec. 54-123. Mechanical and electronic amusement devices.**

The license fees for mechanical and electronic amusement devices, as provided in section 10-187, shall be as follows:

- (1) Initial application for license .....~~\$100~~250.00
- (2) Renewal application (received by January 15th).....~~50~~100.00
- (3) Renewal application (after January 15th).....150.00
- ~~(3) License fee, per pool table or amusement device.....100.00~~

Section 3. Section 54-466 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

**Sec. 54-466. Spencer Park motor vehicle entry fees.**

The following schedule of motor vehicle entry fees shall apply only to Spencer Park. There shall be no charge for bicycles ridden into the park or for pedestrians. (Note: Status of residency to obtain the resident discount shall be determined by the vehicle registration.)

(9)	Resident discounted off-season daily permit .....	3.00
(10)	<u>Weekend (Saturdays &amp; Sundays) &amp; holidays (Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day) daily permit .....</u>	<u>15.00</u>
(11)	<u>Resident discount on weekend &amp; holidays daily permit.....</u>	<u>7.00</u>

Section 4. Section 54-467 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

**Sec. 54-467. Bloomer Park and Yates Park motor vehicle entry fees.**

The following schedule of motor vehicle entry fees shall apply to Bloomer Park and Yates Park. There shall be no charge for bicycles ridden into the park or for pedestrians. Annual permits and senior citizen and handicap passes shall be honored at Bloomer Park and Yates Park.

(1)	Bloomer/Yates annual pass.....	\$ <del>30</del> 35.00
(2)	Bloomer/Yates daily permit.....	5.00
(3)	Bus rate (11 passenger or greater capacity), twice the annual permit fee.	

Section 5. Section 54-470 of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended as follows:

**Sec. 54-470. Museum.**

The following schedule of fees shall apply to the non-exclusive use of the Rochester Hills Museum at Van Hoosen Farm:

- (1) Tour admission fees:
  - a. Adult .....\$5.00
  - b. Senior citizen .....3.00
  - c. Student .....3.00
- (2) Conferences, seminars, meetings and group use:
  - a. Conference room, per hour .....50.00
  - b. Dairy barn, per hour .....100.00
  - c. Calf barn, per hour .....100.00
- (3) Wedding ceremony fees:
  - a. Non-Resident—Three-Three-hour minimum .....~~78~~00.00
  - b. Resident—Three hour minimum .....~~67~~00.00
  - c. Additional hour or portion of an hour.....~~202~~50.00
  - d. Reservation-~~fee~~ of museum grounds for wedding photography only (per hour or portion of an hour).....75.00
  - e. Wedding ceremony, reception or event cancellation-~~fee~~:
    - Nine months or more before-~~ceremony~~.....~~50.00~~50% of security depositforfeited
    - Less than nine months before-~~ceremony~~.....~~200.00~~100% of security depositforfeited
- (4) Fee for Reception or event lasting 6-12 hours:
  - a. Resident.....2,000.00
  - b. Non-resident.....2,250.00
  - c. Additional hour or portion of an hour.....200.00
- (5) Fee for Reception orevent lasting 1-5 hours:
  - a. Per hour.....200.00
  - b. Change event date.....50.00
- (6) Security deposit fees:
  - a. Reception or event .....500.00
  - b. Wedding ceremony .....250.00
- (47) Commercial use of museum buildings and grounds:
  - a. Buildings—Interior:
    - One-half day (~~up to~~less than four hours) .....750.00
    - Full day (four to eight hours) .....1,500.00

b. Grounds:	
One-half day ( <del>up to</del> <u>less than</u> four hours) .....	500.00
Full day ( <del>up</del> <u>four</u> to eight hours) .....	1,000.00
c. Commercial photography use fee:	
Full-day (up to eight hours) .....	50.00
Calendar year .....	250.00
<b>(58) Museum membership fees:</b>	
a. Annual individual membership.....	30.00
b. Annual individual plus membership .....	40.00
c. Annual family membership.....	50.00
d. Annual business partner membership .....	250.00
e. Three-year individual membership .....	75.00
f. Three-year individual plus membership .....	105.00
g. Three-year family membership.....	135.00

Section 6. Division 2A shall be added to Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills as follows:

**DIVISION 2A.FIRE DEPARTMENT**

**Sec. 54-199. Administrative charges.**

Fire Department billings will include an administrative charge of 20% of the total billing or \$100.00, whichever is less.

**Sec. 54-200. Recreational fire permit.**

The fee for an annual recreational fire permit shall be \$25.00.

**Sec. 54-201. Cost recovery fees.**

The fees for cost recovery billings (one hour minimum and 15 minute increments after initial hour) shall be as follows:

(1) Administrative vehicle .....	\$15.00
(2) Utility vehicle.....	15.00
(3) Air tender .....	15.00
(4) Ambulance .....	25.00
(5) Ladder truck .....	125.00

(6)	Rescue truck .....	115.00
(7)	Engine .....	85.00
(8)	Fire Chief .....	actual hourly wage plus benefits
(9)	Deputy Chief .....	actual hourly wage plus benefits
(10)	Battalion Chief .....	actual hourly wage plus benefits
(11)	Captain/Fire Marshal .....	actual hourly wage plus benefits
(12)	Captain/Training Officer.....	actual hourly wage plus benefits
(13)	Captain/EMS Coordinator .....	actual hourly wage plus benefits
(14)	Lieutenant/Fire Inspector .....	actual hourly wage plus benefits
(15)	Communications supervisor.....	actual hourly wage plus benefits

**Sec. 54-202. Educational services.**

(1)	CPR class (per person/per class).....	\$20.00
(2)	First aid and CPR class (per person/per class).....	30.00

There is a \$10.00 additional charge (per person/per class) for nonresidents.

**Sec. 54-203. Emergency medical services.**

(1)	Basic life support .....	\$425.00
(2)	Advanced life support .....	600.00
(3)	Advanced life support (ALS2).....	750.00
(4)	Fee for oxygen .....	40.00
(5)	Fee for transportation (per mile).....	10.00
(6)	Fee for defibrillation .....	50.00
(7)	Extrication.....	250.00

- (8) Treat without transport.....150.00
- (9) Operating while intoxicated (OWI). Billings will be based upon actual expenditures incurred. (One hour minimum and 15 minute increments after initial hour).
- (10) Any remaining medical billing balance less than \$100.00 after insurance payment will be waived for Rochester Hills residents, with the exception of incidents related to OWI.
- (11) Return check fee .....30.00

**Sec. 54-204. Fire incidents.**

The fees for fire incident reports shall be as follows:

- (1) First page.....\$4.00
- (2) Each additional page .....1.00

**Sec. 54-205. Patient care.**

The fees for patient care reports shall be as follows:

- (1) First page.....\$4.00
- (2) Each additional page .....1.00

**Sec. 54-206. Fire safety inspections.**

The fees for fire safety inspections shall be as follows:

- (1) Initial and first re-inspection.....No charge
- (2) Second re-inspection (same violation) unresolved .....\$75.00
- (3) Third re-inspection (same violation) unresolved .....125.00
- (4) Fourth re-inspection (same violation) unresolved .....175.00
- (5) Fifth and subsequent re-inspections (same violation)unresolved .....250.00

**Sec. 54-207. Fireworks/Pyrotechnics display permit.**

The fees for fireworks/pyrotechnics display shall be as follows:

- (1) Fireworks .....\$250.00
- (2) On-stage pyrotechnics.....150.00

**Sec. 54-208. Plan reviews.**

The charge for each review by the Fire Department of one-family residential detached condominium, subdivision plat, site plan, unplatted land development, construction plan, or hazardous material plan shall be \$75.00 per hour (one hour minimum and 15 minute increments after initial hour).

**Sec. 54-209. Freedom of information requests.**

The fee for FOIA research shall be \$75.00 per hour (one-hour minimum and 15-minute increments after initial hour).

**Sec. 54-210. Pre-incident surveys.**

Michigan Fire Fighter Right-to-Know Site specific fee:

- (1) Building area less than 12,000 square fee.....\$225.00
- (2) Building area between 12,000 and 25,000 square fee .....300.00
- (3) Building area between 25,000 and 50,000 square feet .....375.00
- (4) Building greater than 50,000 square feet .....525.00

Section 7. Severability. This ordinance and each article, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, part, provision, sentence, word and portion thereof are hereby declared to be severable, and if they or any of them are declared to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby provided that the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 8. Repeal, Effective Date, Adoption.

(1) Repeal. All regulatory provisions contained in other City ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.
