TO ROCHESTER HILLS RESIDENTS:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE ROCHESTER HILLS CITY COUNCIL, in accordance with the Charter for the City of Rochester Hills, Chapter III, Section 3.5, will hold a PUBLIC HEARING on the Proposed Millage Rates and Proposed 2016-2018 Budget Plan, which were submitted by the Mayor and received by City Council, in accordance with the City Charter, at its August 10, 2015 meeting.

The Public Hearing on the 2016-2018 Proposed Budget Plan and the millages that are estimated to be required to support the 2016 Proposed Budget Plan will be held at the Rochester Hills City Council Meeting on Monday, September 14, 2015, commencing at 7:00 p.m., Michigan time, at 1000 Rochester Hills Drive, Rochester Hills, MI 48309.

In addition, during these same proceedings, the Rochester Hills City Council will hold a Public Hearing on the Older Persons Commission (OPC) Budget and the Rochester Avon Recreation Authority (RARA) Budget and millages that are estimated to be required to support their Fiscal Year 2016 Proposed Budgets.

A copy of the Proposed 2016-2018 Budget Plan is on file and available to the public for inspection during regular business hours (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.), at the Office of the City Clerk and the City Hall Resource Center, both located at 1000 Rochester Hills Drive, Rochester Hills, Oakland County, Michigan. A copy of the 2016-2018 Proposed Budget Plan is also on file at the Rochester Hills Public Library, the Older Person's Commission, and is posted on the City's website (www.rochesterhills.org).
