SUBJECT: Receipt of the Rochester-Avon Recreation Authority FY 2025 Proposed Budget and FY 2026-27 Projected Budget

REQUEST:

We are requesting that City Council acknowledge receipt of the Rochester-Avon Recreation Authority (RARA) FY 2025 Proposed Budget and FY 2026-27 Projected Budget.

BACKGROUND:

The RARA Board met on July 17, 2024 to discuss the FY 2025 Proposed RARA Budget. A Public Hearing was held on the Proposed RARA Budget, and the RARA Board approved the FY 2025 RARA Budget.

The RARA FY 2025 Proposed Budget and FY 2026-27 Projected Budget is being submitted in accordance with Article III / Section 2.A of the Interlocal Agreement, which states that annually, by August 1 of each calendar year, the Authority shall submit a budget to each of the parties participating in the program which shall outline the programs to be carried on for the ensuing year, together with the costs projected for those programs.

In accordance with Article IV / Section 2.A of the Interlocal Agreement, RARA shall each year develop an annual budget in such detail as required by Act 2 of the Public Acts of 1968 of the State of Michigan, which shall include all sums necessary to carry on the programs authorized herein for all residents, including enrichment classes, adult/youth sports leagues, etc...

The FY 2025 RARA Budget begins January 1, 2025.

RECOMMENDATION:

We recommend that City Council acknowledge receipt of the Rochester-Avon Recreation Authority FY 2025 Proposed Budget and FY 2026-27 Projected Budget at the City Council's first meeting in August in accordance with Article III / Section 2.A of the Interlocal Agreement.
