SUBJECT: Renaming Water & Sewer Technical Committee to Water System Advisory Council and new appointments

REQUEST:

The Department of Public Services recommends that the Water & Sewer Technical Committee shall be renamed and re-established as the Water System Advisory Council (WASC) and that the current members of the WSTC should be reappointed to serve as members of the WASC along with the appointment of Tracey A. Balint, P.E., Public Utilities Engineering Manager and Leon Luedeman, Water & Sewer Operations Manager to the WSAC.

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Base upon a July 5, 2018 correspondence (attached) from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), the administrative rules promulgated under the Michigan Safe Drinking Water Act, 1976 PA 399, as amended (Act 399) have been amended. More specifically, for water supplies serving a population of 50,000 or more or consecutive systems serving a population of 50,000 or more, a Water System Advisory Council must be established in accordance with R 325.10410(7).

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Services recommends that the Water & Sewer Technical Committee shall be renamed and re-established as the Water System Advisory Council (WASC) for the purposes authorized under, and in accordance with, the Lead and Copper provisions of the Michigan Administrative Code, specifically Rule R 325.10410(7), and that the current members of the WSTC should be reappointed to serve as members of the WASC along with the appointment of Tracey A. Balint, P.E., Public Utilities Engineering Manager and Leon Luedeman, Water & Sewer Operations Manager to the WSAC.
