CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of Act 284, Public Acts of 1972, (profit corporations), or Act 162, Public Acts of 1982 (nonprofit corporations), the undersigned corporation executes the following Certificate:

3. Article VI of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended to read as follows:

1) Upon dissolution, remaining assets must be used exclusively for exempt purposes such as charitable, religious, educational and/or scientific purposes.

2) ~~PROBIB~~ Motor City Baseball Club must be operated to avoid liability for excise taxes under IRS sections 4941(d), 4942, 4943(c), 4944 and 4945(d)

Article 11 is hereby amended to read as follows:
The nonprofit corporation is being established as an educational youth baseball program that is designed to develop baseball skills and provide an environment of competition.

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6. Nonprofit corporation only: Member, shareholder, or board approval

The foregoing amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was duly adopted on the 27 day of September, 2011 by the (check one of the following)


