Adoption of Resolution opting into Agreement with the Oakland County Clerk to conduct elections as proposed and discussed

Ms. Bev Jasinski, City Clerk, explained that, as part of the new State-mandated election consolidation laws, it is now necessary for municipalities to "opt in" to conducting the February and May elections. If a community chooses to "opt out" of these elections, the County--not the schools--will conduct them. Ms. Jasinski noted that the schools are disputing this new policy and may bring legal action against the County. She requested that the Council pass a resolution to "opt in", allowing Rochester Hills to conduct the May election. She stressed that the Clerk's

Department is more experienced in doing so and it will benefit Rochester Hill's voters who are more familiar with the City's election processes.

A motion was made by Robbins, seconded by Duistermars, that this matter be Adopted by Resolution.

Resolved that the Rochester Hills City Council on behalf of the City of Rochester Hills allows the City Clerk to indicate to Oakland County that the City will opt in to conduct school elections for the purpose of completing the report to be issued to the Secretary of State by the Oakland County Clerk no later than January 31, 2005.
