

Charter Millage Technical Review Committee

Under Article VII, Section .02 of the Rules of Procedure, it states that Committees shall be established by Council resolution setting for the following:

- 1) Purpose and Charge
 - a. Charge/responsibility of the Committee
 - 1) *To study the City Charter - authorized and special voted millages.*
 - 2) *To consider the possibility of combining millages, such as for Public Safety.*
 - 2) *Consider possible amendment or modifications of both the Charter-authorized and special voted millages.*
 - b. Expected results including, but not limited to, time line.
 - 1) *Make recommendations to City Council regarding potential changes to the Charter and millages based on its study; including no changes within one (1) year.*
- 2) Membership and selection, including number of members, solicitation of members and qualifications of members:
 - a. Each committee shall included at least two (2) and not more than three (3) Council Members.

Two (2) Council Members
 - b. Committees shall include citizen members which shall be appointed by Council.

Two (2) Citizen Members
 - c. Committees may include Administrative Staff Members which shall be appointed by the Mayor

One (1) Member of the Clerks Office (i.e. Deputy Clerk) and other Staff Members as appropriate (such as Finance Director)
 - d. Committees may include one (1) Rochester Hills Government Youth Council (RHGYC) Representative selected by the Youth Council

One (1) RHGYC Member
 - e. Term of appointment, where appropriate

The term shall be for one year, with the first to expire December 2008
