Charter Millage Technical Review Committee

Under Article VII, Section .02 of the Rules of Procedure, it states that Committees shall be established by Council resolution setting for the following:

- 1) Purpose and Charge
 - a. Charge/responsibility of the Committee
 - 1) To study the City Charter authorized and special voted millages.
 - 2) To consider the possibility of combining millages, such as for Public Safety.
 - 2) Consider possible amendment or modifications of both the Charterauthorized and special voted millages.
 - b. Expected results including, but not limited to, time line.
 - 1) Make recommendations to City Council regarding potential changes to the Charter and millages based on its study; including no changes within one (1) year.
- 2) Membership and selection, including number of members, solicitation of members and qualifications of members:
 - a. Each committee shall included at least two (2) and not more than three (3) Council Members.
 - Two (2) Council Members
 - b. Committees shall include citizen members which shall be appointed by Council.
 - Two (2) Citizen Members
 - c. Committees may include Administrative Staff Members which shall be appointed by the Mayor
 - One (1) Member of the Clerks Office (i.e. Deputy Clerk) and other Staff Members as appropriate (such as Finance Director)
 - d. Committees may include one (1) Rochester Hills Government Youth Council (RHGYC) Representative selected by the Youth Council
 - One (1) RHGYC Member
 - e. Term of appointment, where appropriate

The term shall be for one year, with the first to expire December 2008
