(g) Past convictions of the applicant for any of the following: (i) A felony. (ii) A crime involving the excessive use of alcoholic liquor. (iii) A crime involving any of the following: (a) Gambling. (b) Prostitution. (c) Weapons. (d) Violence. (e) Tax evasion. (f) Fraudulent activity. (g) Controlled substances (iv) A misdemeanor of such a nature that it may impair the ability of the applicant to operate a licensed business in a safe and competent manner. (v) Sentencing for any of the offenses specified in this subrule after a plea of nolo contendere. (h) The applicant's excessive use of alcoholic liquor.
