The National League of Cities (NLC) 81<sup>st</sup> Congress of Cities and Exposition will be he held November 30 through December 4, 2004 in Indianapolis, IN. Council Member Hill and myself will be attending the Congress; therefore Council Member Hill and I will not be able to attend the December 1<sup>st</sup> Regular Council Meeting.

Section 7.7, President of Council, of the *City Charter* states that the "Council shall, at its first regular meeting in December of each year, elect one (1) of its Members to serve as President." By rescheduling the December 1<sup>st</sup> meeting to December 15<sup>th</sup>, December 8<sup>th</sup> will then be the "first regular Meeting in December", allowing Council to meet the criteria set forth in the Charter and Council's Rules and still provide an opportunity for all Council members to be present at the meeting for the election and appointments.

A resolution has been provided in the packet for your consideration. If Council adopts the resolution to change the meeting, the Clerk will then provide the appropriate notification pursuant to the Open Meeting's Act.
