


Budget Highlights

- Explore alternative pavement repair options for Major Road and Local Street maintenance
- Utilizing pipe bursting technology on the South Blvd. Water Main Project as a trenchless method of replacing buried sewer lines without the need for a traditional construction trench.
- A new web based weather service that is available from any location with a PC; a predictive service that sends DPS staff weather alerts via email or text on user set thresholds.
- Stagger Your Start Program designed to decrease sudden water pressure drops to Rochester Hills and provide more consistent pressure to our customers.
