RE: Police School Liaison Program

During the 2005 Budget Workshop, City Council communicated that they would like to have the police representation in the Rochester Community Schools Police Liaison Program, more closely match the community composition in the student population. This proportionate representation would most likely mean replacing one Rochester Officer with an Oakland County Deputy from the Rochester Hills substation. Currently, there are two Rochester Officers in the program, with Rochester students making up approximately 10% of the population.

I informed the Council that there is an agreement between RCS, Oakland Township, Rochester, and Rochester Hills that would need to be amended in order to accomplish this change. Since there is an agreement in place, Council requested that this issue be addressed prior to the 2006 budget season.
