NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE ROCHESTER HILLS CITY COUNCIL, in accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Act 267 of the Public Acts of 1976 as amended, will hold a Public Hearing to consider the approval of an amendment to the Consent Judgment in the case, VORH Associates, LLC, and 400 North Adams, LLC v City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County Circuit Court Case No. 96-530684-CH, concerning the development and use of property located east of Adams Rd. and north of Walton Rd., Parcel No. 15-08-303-035 in the City of Rochester Hills, Oakland County, MI. The current application includes the proposed spilt of this parcel to allow for the development of a Starbucks Coffee shop with a drive through in the existing parking lot in front of Von Maur.



The Public Hearing on the proposed amendment of the Consent Judgment will be held at the Rochester Hills City Council Meeting on Monday, February 28, 2022, commencing at 7:00 PM, at the Rochester Hills Municipal Offices, 1000 Rochester Hills Drive, Rochester Hills, Michigan 48309.
