Public Safety and Infrastructure Technical Review Committee

Under Article VII, Section .02 of the Rules of Procedure, it states that Committees shall be established by Council resolution setting for the following:

- 1. Purpose and Charge
 - a. Charge/responsibility of the Committee
 - To analyze Public Safety and Infrastructure Funding and propose short and long term strategies to City Council for review and deliberation.

Specific Items Mentioned:

- Public Safety staffing levels for Rochester Hills for the shortand long-term future with the analysis including appropriate metrics for Rochester Hills.
- 2) Analysis of service provided as compared to the associated cost and level of safety delivered.
- Funding levels and respective sources with particular attention to the analysis of dedicated millage funding versus general fund contributions, how other cities fund their police services and provide recommendation that emphasizes long term sustainable funding for Police Services.
- 4) Funding levels and respective sources for Infrastructure.
- 5) Alternative strategies of repair and levels of rehabilitation/replacement with respect to the PMI index achieved and resultant life span of Infrastructure.
- 6) Capture the existing debt millage for possible revenue source.
- 7) Other millage items that may be brought forth by City Council, Administration or Public, especially with regards to a dedicated Parks millage.

2. Membership

- a. Each committee shall include at least two (2) and not more than three(3) Council Members.
- b. Committees shall include citizen members which shall be appointed by City Council.

- c. Committees may include Administrative Staff Members, which shall be appointed by the Mayor.
- d. Committee may include two (2) Rochester Hills Government Youth Council (RHGYC) Representative selected by the Youth Council.
- e. Term of appointment, where appropriate.
