SUBJECT: Street resolution

REQUEST:

Adoption of a street resolution to place newly constructed Balmoral Blvd., Lincolnshire Court, Lincolnshire Drive, Piccadilly Court, Piccadilly Drive, Thatcher Court, and Thatcher Drive within the City Local Street System for the purpose of obtaining funds under Act 51, P.A. 1951, as amended.

BACKGROUND:

The resolution is for newly constructed streets within the existing platted subdivision plan of "Butler Ridge No. 1 & Butler Ridge No. 2" in Section 19.

The State of Michigan requires that a street resolution be adopted from the governing body in order to place a public street into the City Local Street System for the purpose of obtaining funds under Act 51, P.A. 1951 (as amended). In 1999, the State initiated that all public streets, including those within platted subdivisions, must have an adopted street resolution by the jurisdictional road agency.

A certified street resolution will need to be returned to the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT), accompanied with City Mileage Certification, Act 51 Reports by April 18, 2005. Upon City Council approval, please provide a certified resolution so we may include the resolution within our City Mileage Certification Reports for mailing this year.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Service recommends adoption of this resolution to place newly constructed Balmoral Blvd., Lincolnshire Court, Lincolnshire Drive, Piccadilly Court, Piccadilly Drive, Thatcher Court, and Thatcher Drive within the City Local Street System for the purpose of obtaining funds under Act 51, P.A. 1951, as amended.
