AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 98, TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE III, MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, SECTION 98-61 ADOPTION BY REFERENCE, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, BY RE-ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE; REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PRESCRIBE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.
THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS ORDAINS:
Section 1. Chapter 98, Article III, Section 98-61 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rochester Hills shall be amended:
Sec. 98-61. Adoption by Reference
The Michigan Vehicle Code, MCL 257.1 through 257.923, MSA 9.1801 9.2633 as amended and as may be amended in the future, is adopted by reference.
Section 2. Severability. This ordinance and each article, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, part, provision, sentence, word and portion thereof are hereby declared to be severable, and if they or any of them are declared to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby provided that the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
Section 3. Repeal, Effective Date, Adoption.
(1) <u>Repeal</u> . All regulatory provisions contained in other City ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.
(2) <u>Effective Date</u> . This ordinance shall become effective on, the day following its publication in the Rochester Eccentric on
