SUBJECT:	Carbon Cutting Edges and Carbide Blades

# REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize the purchase of one-hundred seventy-one (171)  $7/8" \times 5" \times 60"$  carbide blades to Valk Manufacturing Company, New Kingston, Pennsylvania for a not-to-exceed amount of \$44,460.00 and the purchase of ten (10)  $5/8" \times 8" \times 72"$  and ten (10)  $5/8" \times 8" \times 84"$  carbon cutting edges to Michigan CAT, Novi, Michigan for a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,305.40. The combined purchase of the blades from the two vendors is a total not-to-exceed amount of \$45,765.40.

### **REASON FOR PURCHASE:**

The City, acting as the Lead Agency on behalf of themselves and the City of Farmington Hills issued an Invitation to Bid for the purchase of Carbon Cutting Edges and Carbide Blades. The lowest responsive, responsible bidder was Valk Manufacturing Company at a bid price of \$260.00 each for the carbide blades and Michigan CAT for the  $5/8" \times 8" \times 72"$  carbon cutting edges at \$60.69 each and the  $5/8" \times 8" \times 84"$  carbon cutting edges at \$69.85 each.

Carbide cutting blades are used on the City's snow plow truck's underbody scraper plows. The cutting blade contacts with the road "cutting" the snow and ice from the road surface. Carbide cutting blades-last up to five times longer than carbon steel blades, requiring less blade changes keeping the truck on the road working and less down time in the shop on the hoist.

Carbon cutting edges are used on the City's two road graders for snow plowing in the winter. Due to the road grader's blade not having a "shock absorber" as the plow trucks do, carbide edges are too brittle for this application.

## BUDGET:

Funding is included in the FY 2014 Adopted Budget.

Due to the extreme 2014 winter weather which required extensive snow plowing operations, the Department of Public Services used far more carbide and cutting blades than in a typical year - and has depleted their inventory. Additional blades are being requested (beyond a typical annual amount to be replaced) to not only equip the snow plow fleet but to also replenish the snow plow blade inventory in preparation for another winter season.

If approved by City Council, Fiscal shall bring forth a 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2014 budget amendment.
