SUBJECT: Water Storage Reservoirs, Engineering Services, City File No. E09-052

REQUEST:

To adopt the recommendation of the Water & Sewer Technical Review Committee and move forward with the construction of two, 3 million gallon water storage facilities. Based on that recommendation, the Department of Public Services recommends awarding a contract to Tetra Tech, Inc. of Detroit, Michigan in the amount not-to-exceed \$508,985.00 as part of the total project cost and authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract on behalf of the City.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The water storage facility project has been discussed at previous City Council meetings. Please review the agenda summary submitted by the Department of Public Services for the February 8, 2010 City Council meeting for detailed background and benefit information (attached).

Per the May 3, 2010 City Council meeting, it was requested that the Department of Public Services review alternate sites and determine the feasibility and associated costs with locating the reservoirs in different locations. Attached are alternate site location maps and estimated construction costs for all sites under consideration. Each site has four cost scenarios associated with it. The construction cost estimates do not include the purchase of property which will be determined at a later date and will be included as part of the total project cost.

If approved by City Council, a 3rd Quarter Budget Amendment will be prepared to provide funding for engineering services for the Water Reservoir project. Funding will initially be drawn from Water & Sewer Capital Fund Retained Earnings.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Services recommends awarding a contract to Tetra Tech, Inc. of Detroit, Michigan in the amount not-to-exceed \$508,985 as part of the total project cost and authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract on behalf of the City. The Department of Public Services recommends either site B-1 or B-3 for the east central water storage reservoir. Research indicates that all three proposed northwest water storage reservoir sites (A-1, A-2 & A-3) have similar costs, benefits and functionality. It is therefore requested that City Council determine a preferred site.
