OAKLAND COUNTY DRAIN COMMISSIONER NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGREEMENT TO ENLARGE THE WOLF DRAINAGE DISTRICT

John P. McCulloch, Drain Commissioner for the County of Oakland, Michigan, acting for and on behalf of the Wolf Drainage District, has received a request to add 1.30 acres to the existing Wolf Drainage District.

The Wolf Drainage District at present contains approximately 578.3 acres. There is capacity in the existing Wolf Drain to serve the lands to be added without detriment to or diminution of the Wolf Drainage District.

Proceedings have been undertaken according to the provisions of Section 433, Chapter 18 of Act No. 40 of the Michigan Drain Code of 1956, as amended, to enlarge the Wolf Drainage District.

NOW, THEREFORE, notice is hereby given that it is the intention of the Wolf Drainage District to enter into an agreement providing for the addition of the following described lands to the Wolf Drainage District attached hereto in Exhibit 'A'.

Chapter 20 Drain Enlargement: Design Engineer's Certification

It is our engineering opinion that the outlet into the Wolf Drain for the proposed Flagstar Bank development is the most reasonable available outlet for this project. A portion of the site already drains into the Wolf Drainage District, but is not included as part of the district. This request for enlargement of the district will ratify that portion of the site already draining into the district as well as include the remainder of the site. The total contribution will be an additional 1.30 acres into the overall 578.3 acres that encompasses the Wolf Drainage District.

Storm water will be discharged from the Flagstar Bank facility at a restricted agricultural rate. The runoff from the existing site ultimately entered into the same system at an unrestricted rate. The net release rate would be decreased due to the redevelopment of this site. It is our opinion that the Wolf Drain has adequate capacity to support this discharge into the system without detriment to or diminution of the drainage service presently provided.

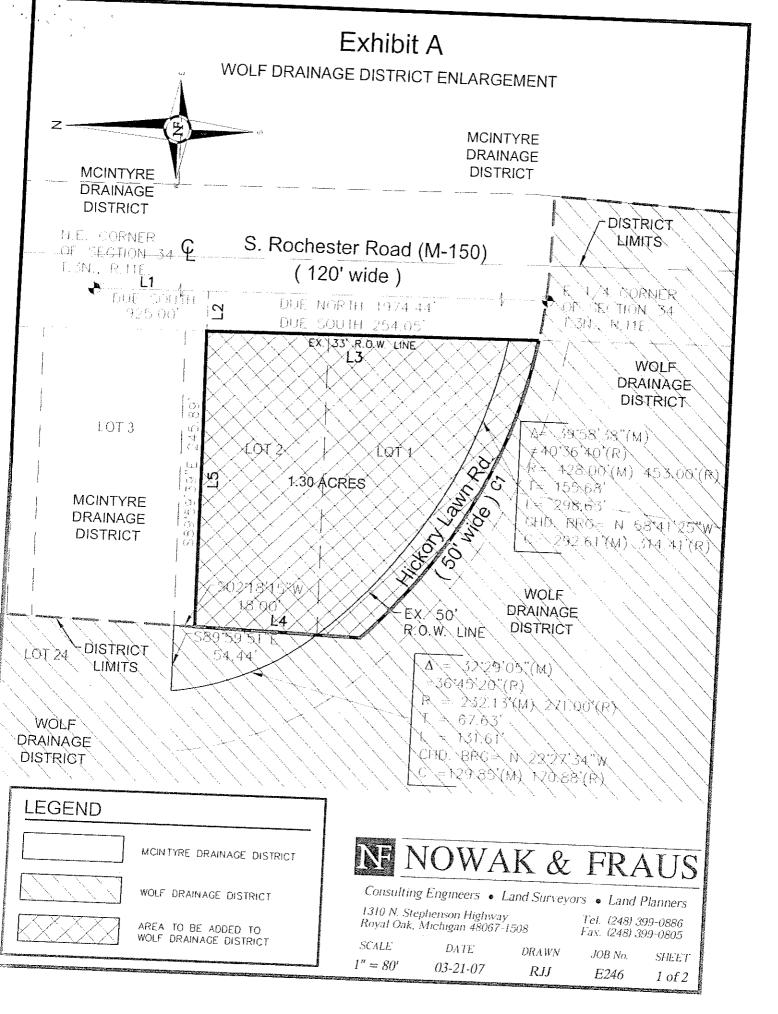
