I just wanted to follow if you had a chance to do a field review of the signal timing for EB Auburn at Livernois during afternoon peak hour (4:30-5:30PM), to possiblity extend the green phase to assist with through & left turn movements. Per the attached maps we validated cut-through traffic concerns for the Gildewell Subdivsion located at northwest quadrant of the intersection. EB Auburn Road traffic will queued back to 1600' + /- west of Livernois Road and were interested in lessening the effect of Dearborn to Bagley cut-through traffic.

Also, could you advise what the flash schedule is for Avondale Middle School driveway at Auburn Road (Signal I.D.#4214).
