Resolved that the Rochester Hills City Council hereby authorizes the amendment of an existing Blanket Purchase Order to Home Depot, of Rochester Hills, Michigan, for the purchase of various supplies, including hardware and building products, by the increased amount of \$20,000 for the new total amount not-to-exceed \$45,000 through October 1, 2004.
