Baum, to each of the new members, Aaron Baum, Natalie Baum, and Steven Baum, on or about August 25, 2011; to drop Alon D. Kaufman as member through redemption of 55% membership interest in the limited liability company, on or about August 31, 2011; and to transfer 94% membership interest from Elliott Baum, Trustee of the Elliott Baum Revocable Living Trust dated 12/7/84, to new member BR Restaurants Holdings, LLC; and members Aaron Baum, Natalie Baum, and Steven Baum each transfer 2% membership interest to new member BR Restaurant Holdings, LLC on or about October 2, 2011.

Per MLCC records, BRR-Rochester membership is as follows: Elliott Baum, Trust: 45% and Alon Kaufman: 55%.


On or about August 25, 2011, Elliot Baum's Trust gifted .9% to his children Aaron Baum, Steven Baum, and Natalie Baum.
