SUBJECT: Hamlin Road Widening between Crooks to Livernois; 1998 Rochester Industrial Dr.

REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize payment in the amount of \$ 1,918.00 to Ackerman Ackerman & Dynkowski for reimbursement of the review for the appraisal work related to the settlement of Parcel H-11, 1998 Rochester Industrial Drive for the Hamlin Road widening project.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The Hamlin Road widening project needed to acquire right-of-way from adjacent property owners. The City received right-of-entry to allow construction of the road project but acceptance of the final payment potentially owed the property owner was challenged. The City attorney, City right-of-way consultant (Hubbell, Roth & Clark) and City Construction Engineer for the project (Orchard, Hiltz & McCliment, Inc.) continued to work to reach closure on the right-of-way acquisition with the property owner and his attorney.

A copy of the payment made by Mr. Ackerman to the review appraiser consultant, Mark Sheppell is attached for reference and justification of payment.

BUDGET:

The funds for the highway easement payment were expensed and included in the 2009 budget. The highway and public utility easement/right-of-way acquisition will be paid 100% with City funds with 80% being reimbursed by Federal Funding.
