**SUBJECT:** Pavement Marking Program - 2005

### **REQUEST:**

The Department of Public Service recommends awarding the contract for the 2005 Pavement Marking Program to R.S. Contracting, Inc. of Fraser, Michigan in the amount of \$26,120.00.

The Department of Public Service also requests City Council authorize a 5% contingency to allow for quantity adjustments based on final measurements verified in the field.

### **REASON FOR PURCHASE:**

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) recently received bids for their 2005 County-Wide Pavement Marking Program. R.S. Contracting, Inc. was read as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,083,140.00. Since the City's contract is relatively small in comparison to RCOC's, the Department of Public Service requested that R.S. Contracting, Inc. allow the City to utilize the unit prices awarded through the RCOC contract. R.S. Contracting has agreed to permit the City to take full advantage of the RCOC cost savings.

The Annual Pavement Marking Program involves contracting for the application striping on over 35 miles of City major roads. In addition to the annual striping program, a contract for the placement of pavement legends, i.e. "Left-turn" arrows, "Stop Bars", "X-Walks", etc. will be forthcoming once RCOC receives bids for their 2005 Pavement Legend Program. The Department of Public Service intends on utilizing the RCOC bid prices for the City's 2005 Pavement Legend Program, similarly to the 2005 Pavement Marking Program, and use the balance of the City's remaining 2005 Pavement Marking Budget of \$4,880.00.

The Department of Public Service requesting authorization from City Council to move forward with the proposed 2005 Pavement Marking Program in the amount of \$26,120.00 and authorize a 5% contingency to allow for quantity adjustments based on final measurements verified in the field.
